Re: ESSER III Spending Plan / Continuous Learning Plan Update

The following information describes the spending considerations for ESSER III funds and the most recent updates to our Continuous Learning Plan.

- Our ESSER III Funds Total \$408,589.11
- Our first priority for using these funds is to mitigate learning loss associated with the disrupted school year we just experienced.
- Some examples include a more robust summer school offering, after school tutoring for the upcoming school year, professional development for staff members, and more access to proven remote curriculum.
- Special Populations such as students with individual learning plans, and other struggling learners will be at the forefront of our decision making process when it comes to spending our federal dollars. Examples include priority class assignments and access to remediation. If special transportation needs are identified, we may choose to spend money to insure access to remediation.
- 20% of our ESSER III allocation will automatically be set aside for evidence-based activities to address learning loss.
- Other priorities such as social distancing will also be considered for these funds.
- While we feel confident that masks will not be required nor necessary from the state or local levels, we will continue to follow, CDC, State, and Local Health Department direction on this matter.
- After receiving public input on our spending plan our updated Continuous Learning Plan will be reposted on our website.
